ANESTHESIA: General.

- PREOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS:
1. Idiopathic neuropathy.
 2. Compression neuropathy of left proximal tibial nerve at the level of the soleus sling.
 3. Compression neuropathy of deep peroneal nerve, dorsum of foot.
 4. Nontraumatic compartment syndrome, posterior and deep compartment, lower leg.

- POSTOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS:
1. Idiopathic neuropathy.
 2. Compression neuropathy of left proximal tibial nerve at the level of the soleus sling.
 3. Compression neuropathy of deep peroneal nerve, dorsum of foot.
 4. Nontraumatic compartment syndrome, posterior and deep compartment, lower leg.

- PROCEDURE:
- On the left:
1. Decompression neuroplasty of proximal tibial nerve at the level of the soleus sling.
 2. Posterior and deep compartment fasciotomies.
 3. Deep peroneal nerve decompression neuroplasty.
 4. Tenotomy of extensor hallucis brevis tendon.
